## Subject: Illumination of the IMO building and other emblematic landmarks to mark World Maritime Day on 29 September 2022

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization launched, on World Maritime Day in 2021, an initiative to light up in blue colour the IMO building and the Seafarer Memorial, as well as other emblematic landmarks around the world. The initiative has since been adopted as an annual symbolic effort to unite the maritime community on every World Maritime Day and raise awareness of the vital contribution of shipping to the world.

Building on last year's success of this initiative, the Secretary-General has the honour to announce that, to promote this year's World Maritime theme, "**New technologies for greener shipping**", IMO Headquarters will be bathed in "blue and green" light on the evening of 29 September 2022.
